Sub: Furnishing of the list of the students admitted in MDS Course(s)/PG Diploma Course(s) (Both under Government and/or Management Quota) at Dental Colleges during the academic session 2016-17.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the last date upto which the students can be admitted/ joined against stray vacancies arising due to any reason in MDS Course(s) / PG Diploma Course(s) is 31st May of every year as per Time Schedule for PG courses as prescribed in "Dental Council of India (Establishment of New Dental Colleges, Opening of New of Higher Course of study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity in Dental Colleges) (8th Amendment) Regulations, 2016".

2. Accordingly, all the dental colleges are under statutory obligation to furnish the list of the students admitted by them in MDS Course(s) / PG Diploma Course(s) (Both under Govt. & Management Quotas), in the prescribed format, to this Council.
3. The DCI has initiated its efforts to reduce the paper work in the office of the Dental Council of India as the paper is a crushed wood product made with the addition of energy, chemicals and water. In addition, many of the chemicals used in the creation of paper have detrimental effects on the environment and us. Reducing our use of wood will allow our forests to serve a more important role - collecting and storing carbon from the atmosphere and ameliorating the build up of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere and the resulting climate change - not to mention the role of our forests in providing habitat and allowing biodiversity to thrive. The most effective way to save paper is to use less. We need to work electronically and manage our printing to use the least amount possible.
4. In view of the above, the college authorities of all dental colleges are hereby directed to upload the details of students, admitted in MDS Course(s) / PG Diploma Course(s) at their dental institutions for the academic session 2016-17, on DCI Website, using their already allotted login credentials, **by 31.05.2016(12:00 mid-night), positively**, failing which it will be presumed that the college authorities have not admitted any student in MDS Course(s) / PG Diploma Course(s) at their college for the academic session 2016-17.
5. The online module for uploading the details of students shall be disabled at 12:00 mid-night on 31.05.2016, and no request for extension of time to upload the above details of students shall be considered, therefore, you are requested to make available all arrangements to complete the above task in time so as to take necessary action by the DCI in a time bound manner.
6. In case, any admission(s) is/are made in violation of Revised MDS Course Regulations, 2007 or the Time Schedule for the academic session 2016-17 or non compliance of uploading the details of the students on DCI website or in violation of the provision of the Dentists Act and Regulations made thereunder, the provisions of the Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 providing for non-recognition of dental qualification in respect of such students or the provisions of Section 16A for withdrawal of recognition for violation of conditions of admissions, as the case may be, would be initiated against such erring dental college(s).
