Sub: DCI (8th Amendment) Regulations, 2016 regarding Time Schedule for UG / PG courses to be implemented from the academic session 2017-18.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the gazette notification dated 7th March, 2016 on the above noted subject and to say that last date for issue of permission (LOP) for PG schemes by the Central Government for the academic session 2016-17 was **31st March, 2016** as per the old time schedules. Colleges applying for academic session 2017-18 have only 7(seven) days time to apply to the Ministry as per the new time Schedules. It will be hard for the colleges to apply their applications for the academic session 2017-18 within the new time schedule i.e., **15th March, 2016** to **7th April, 2016**.

2. In view of the above and in pursuance of the provision contained in the "NOTE" in the new Schedule of the Regulations, I am directed to convey the approval of the Ministry on the following, as a **one time measure**, that:

(i) the last date of receiving PG applications for the academic session 2017-18 shall be extended **upto 28th April, 2016**; and

(ii) the last date for forwarding the PG applications to DCI by Central Government shall be extended upto **6th May, 2016**.

3. DCI is requested to publicize / circulate the above information through various media including National Daily Newspapers.
